St Michael's Manor Signature Tea

A Darjeeling based blended black leaf tea from West Bengal, India with a musky taste and frequently known as the “Champagne of Teas”.

Assam Golden Broken Orange Pekoe

Grown in North East India this is a tea for any time of the day and of a particular genre with a malty flavour and a strong full body.

Ceylon Orange Pekoe

This Sri Lankan tea uses whole unbroken leaves offering a delicate afternoon tea with subtle, crispy and refreshing flavours.

Earl Grey

A widely popular black tea with a distinctive taste, resulting from a combination of high quality Chinese tea and oil of bergamot creating flowery and citrus flavours.

Lapsang Souchong

This is a speciality of the Fujian Province in China.

The leaves are traditionally roasted in a bamboo basket (honglong) over burning firewood which contributes to the dried longan aroma and distinctive smoky flavour.

Chamomile

Chamomile is the common name for many daisy-like plants of the family Asteraceae.

These lovely flowers produce a golden cup with a creamy and sweet infusion and a light, subtle flavour, famed for a relaxed and calming effect.

Sencha Green

Sencha refers to Japanese “ryokucha”, meaning green tea. It is the most popular tea in Japan and is characterized by a fresh aroma, sweetness and light flavour.

Rwanda PF

A strong, quick brewing small leaf tea with golden liquor and clean taste that is packed full of flavour.
